

Authors' Guidelines for Paper Submission and Publication

5th International Conference on Advances in Materials, Mechanics, Mechatronics and Manufacturing (ICA4M2025)

1. Submission Limit

An author is allowed to submit a maximum of two papers, either as the first author or co-author.

2. Plagiarism Policy

All submitted manuscripts will undergo a plagiarism check using standard software. The overall similarity index must be less than 10%.

- A similarity index of up to 10% is acceptable if the matched content is scattered.
- Even a lower percentage (e.g., 6%) may be unacceptable if:
 - The overlap is concentrated in a single block.
 - It appears in critical sections such as the abstract, conclusion, or methodology.
 - It includes verbatim content without proper citations.

Authors must ensure proper referencing and originality. The editorial team reserves the right to request revisions or reject a paper based on the context and nature of similarity, regardless of the percentage. This plagiarism policy will also be displayed on the conference website.

3. Paper Template

Papers must be prepared strictly in the provided template.

4. Page Limit and Charges

The maximum permissible length of a manuscript is 6 pages. For each additional page beyond the 6-page limit, authors will be charged an additional INR 1000 per page.

5. Submission Process

Authors should submit their manuscripts through the official conference submission portal or email, following the specified format and naming convention. A confirmation email will be sent upon successful submission.

6. Review Process

All submissions will undergo a peer review process to ensure academic quality and relevance to the conference theme.

7. Use of Artificial Intelligence (AI)

The use of AI-generated content in submitted manuscripts is strictly prohibited. Authors must ensure that all submitted work is original, written by humans, and free from any AI-generated material.
